1. Welcome to Nova Gorica – The City of Roses

Nova Gorica is the youngest city in Slovenia, that was built in 1947, right after World war II. The city was designed as a park with large plantations of Roses with over 200 domestic and exotic trees planted all across the city.

Surrounded with high hills and placed next to the valley of river Soča, also called the Emerald river, Nova Gorica has a unique climate. It's the city with most sunny days across the year in Slovenia.

Location of Nova Gorica is a great travel spot, in 45 minutes you can go visit the Alps, or go to the Sea side, with 15 minutes of driving. Or do a walk across the border to Italy, where you can stand with one foot in Italy and the other in Slovenia.

It offers a great culinary experience, various sports activity, full of adrenaline (bungee jumping off the bridge, paragliding or adrenalin park) to easy walks or cycling by the one of the most beautiful rivers in the world.



2. Volleyball club Gorica

Women's volleyball has a long and successful history in Nova Gorica. In over 40 years since the establishment, Volleyball club Gorica is still one of the most trophied women's club in Slovenia.

First women's team was built in 1973, and in just a couple of years the first success came. The team ranked to the 1. division in former Yugoslavia. The success was even of a bigger value, since the team was built from amateur players from the region.

The next success came at the 20th anniversary of the club, when the team played in European Cup, for the very first time.

In 2001 Volleyball club Gorica made it to the 1. division in Slovenian championship. At that time the best players from Gorica were also basic players in Women's national team.

The club was also a winner in MEVZA championship. Over the years, despite the financial crisis that hit the club, was a 3 times winner in Slovenian championship and 4 times winner in Slovenian Cup. And was placed 2. or 3. place 15 times.

In last season Gen-i volley ranked 2. in Slovenian championship and came to the semi finals in Challenge cup.

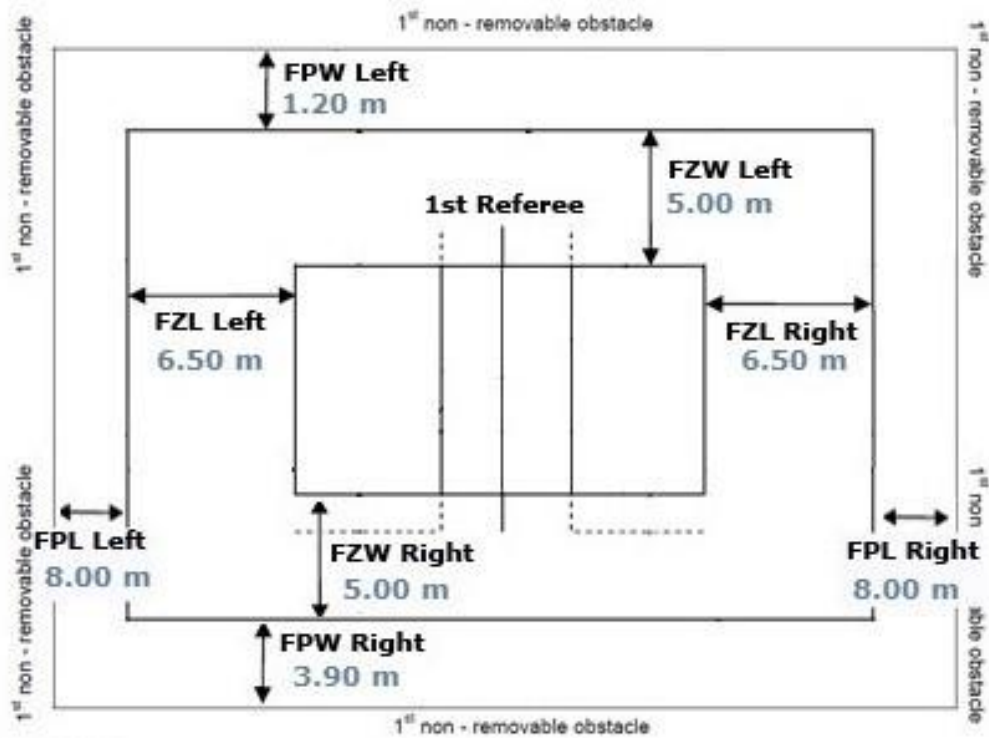

6. Miscellaneous and practical Information Medical care:

- ❖ First aid and medical care will be provided.
- ❖ The organizer will provide first aid and the transportation to the hospital. The hospital is situated 4 km (7 min drive) from the competition hall.
- ❖ The physiotherapist of every team has the possibility to use physio-room in the gym after every morning practice and evening match.
- ❖ Every team has option to get from ICE, if needed.

7. Gaming rules

- The official ball is: Mikasa MVA 200
- In the match: 2x main referees
- Allowed: 14 players on the bench
- Allowed: coach and staff on the bench (4x)
- Every team gets a table for scouting (2 persons on the table)
- The teams get a free Wi- Fi access
- In the game : 2 times coach time-out
- Point distribution:
 - 3-0 or 3-1 (3 points)
 - 3-2 (2 points winner, 1 loser)
- Every game: “Best of Five” (3 winning sets)
 - Last set: until 15 points
- Before and between the games, the teams have the opportunity to do the warm up in the Warm-Up gym
- On the main court: the teams have 30 minutes for the rest warm up
- Before every game players and team members will be introduced
